## Deal Island Chance Lions Club Boat Docking Competition Rules September 6, 2021

- 1. Captains must hold an active commercial fishing license.
- 2. Vessel must be a commercial working vessel as determined by the docking committee. No vessels powered by outboards allowed.
- 3. All lines must be tied half hitch No hoops allowed.
- 4. Participants cannot use pilings to aid in docking. No swinging or pivoting allowed.
- 5. Captain must remain at controls throughout docking.
- 6. 2 Mates required to tie 4 lines one mate port side, one mate starboard side. Bow lines will be tied to cleats.
- 7. Qualifying all eligible participants will receive one run. Top 10 fastest docking times will compete for the prize money.
- 8. Vessels will qualify in the order of received registration forms.
- 9. Final competition running order will be determined by qualifying time, slowest to fastest.
- 10. Final timing of each run will be determined when all four lines are properly tied to the correct poles.
- 11. For safety reasons only the captain and the two mates may remain on the vessel during competition. No consumption of alcohol aboard vessels during the competition. No captain under the influence of alcohol will be permitted to compete.
- 12. Disqualification will be assessed for vessels breaking a piling
- 13. Final competition will be a one run shootout with a 1<sup>st</sup> place \$6000, 2<sup>nd</sup> place \$3000 and 3<sup>rd</sup> place \$1000 payout.
- 14. One entry in the competition per vessel and/or captain.
- 15. No redos unless at request of the race committee.
- 16. Each registered captain/vessel will receive 4 armbands for entry to the festival. Entry fee \$5.00 for spectators.
- 17. All competing vessels and equipment shall be subject to inspection and approval by the committee and judges.
- 18. Captain must at all times consider the safety of their crew, spectators and properties.
- 19. In all matters concerning the boat docking competition, the decision of the boat docking directors shall be considered final.
- 20. The directors of this event hold the right to alter the competition depending on the number of entries. All captains will be notified of any changes to the original format before the event start.
